- 1. Why do you think Destroyer Escorts were so effective at combating the Japanese? What strategies / capabilities made them so destructive?
- 2. Using your knowledge of WWII and the information you learned in the reading, how would an Ameri can defeat potentially impact the war?
- 3. How did Admiral Halsey's decision to go North effect the American defenses at Leyte? Would the outcome of the battle been different if he had not?
- 4. Each ship in Taffy 3 fought heroically to defend the carriers and carry out their mission. Why is the USS SAMUEL B. ROBERTS highlighted as being the most heroic? Is there a more deserving ship in your opinion?
- 5. What were the nicknames for escort carriers? Why do you think they were called this?
- 6. The Japanese center force commander was Admiral Kurita. What was his mission in late October?
- 7. How many ships made up Taffy 3 and what was their mission?
- 8. The text implies that Taffy 3 was not favored to win against the Japanese fleet. What evidence is presented to support this argument? Do you agree with the author?
- 9. Destroyer Escorts have a reputation of being cheaply built. How did this help the ships within the Battle of Leyte Gulf?
- 10. What is the intention of the quote in the last paragraph? What emotions does it invoke upon the reader?
